Eligibility/Rules/Guidelines

The Course is designed for those who are new to Tenrikyo. Especially, it is aimed for those who have attended the Joy Workshop and would like to study the teachings further.

Eligibility:

1. Participants must have attended the Joy Workshop.
2. Participants have not yet completed the Spiritual Development Course or previously attended the Three Day Course.
3. Participants must be 17 years old or older.
4. Participants have not attended the Three Day Course previously.
5. In order to hold the course, we require 4 applicants to be signed up by the application due date.

Rules:

1. Participants must attend all the activities during the course.
2. Alcohol and recreational drugs are prohibited during the course.
3. Participants will share a room with others. They are also required to stay at the church facilities for the duration of the course.
4. If you need to leave the church precincts at any time during the course, you must notify the staff before you leave.
5. Lights are turned off at 10:30 p.m. for bedtime. Participants must be in their respective rooms by that time.

Guidelines:
